- **The Seventeenth Century Palazzo Confalonieri**, was the residence of Confalonieri family. In the Congress Center you can admire a substantial part of its art collection such as **Luca Giordano** and **Giacomo Manzù**
- Three conference rooms dedicated to '**Luca Giordano**': two large canvases by the 17th-century Neapolitan artist dominate the rooms
- In this Auditorium the **Manzù's work of art «Family Saving»**
Giacomo Manzù, was one of the most famous Italian sculptor: in 1964 he completed perhaps his most important work, the "**Doors of Death**" for the St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, **the first new doors in the cathedral in 500 years.**




